KOINONIA TIME - Beginning 12 Sept, every Wed night this year we'll be gathering each week from 6-7:30 PM for *Koinonia Time* as a church family. *Koinonia* is a Greek word that occurs 20 times in the Bible and means “fellowship, sharing in common, communion.” The first occurrence of *koinonia* is in Acts 2:42, “They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.” Christian fellowship is a key aspect of the Christian life.
