He is active as a Member at Large in our San Diego Presbytery providing pulpit supply. 




As stated in previous newsletters, CPP is an emergent curriculum preschool with teachers following the interests of the children and collaborating and learning alongside them. During the month of October, the children were discussing Halloween, costumes, candy, and jack-o-lanterns. All classrooms carved pumpkins and allowed the children to explore the insides. Many classrooms carved jack-o-lanterns and roasted pumpkin seeds. A few classrooms read the book Pumpkin Jack, which is about a little boy named Tim whose first pumpkin he carved was fierce and funny, and he named it Jack. After Halloween was over and Pumpkin Jack began to rot, Tim set it out in the garden and through the weeks he watched it change. By spring, a plant began to grow. The children in the Bee's room asked if they left their Pumpkin Jack out, would a new one grow. That one question, sparked a months long project. After carving a pumpkin into a jack-o-lantern, and naming it "Pumpkin Jack", the children placed it in a soil filled container, and have observed the changes over the months. Since their Pumpkin Jack is placed outside their front door, other classrooms walk by it every day and observe and document the changes as well. When Meghan tours prospective families, Pumpkin Jack is discussed as well. By mid-December, Pumpkin Jack was covered in white, so there has not been much change. The children are hoping to see more changes soon.

cycle of a pumpkin.

There has been a discussion as to why Pumpkin Jack has not changed in a couple months, unlike the book. Teachers are thinking that placing it inside an air-tight container, as opposed to in an open air garden, changed the life cycle of the pumpkin. We will continue to observe Pumpkin Jack as the year progresses. Since most of the children in the Bee's classroom will be entering Kindergarten in the Fall, they will need to decide at the end of the year what to do with Pumpkin Jack.

I was out the other day, using duct tape on the lid of my wheelie bin as the trash trucks beat these up. My neighbor was out doing something in his yard, and came over to speak to me.

We have never been best friends, but I am always cordial to him and his wife. He shared with me his recent and ongoing battle with cancer and his wife's heart surgery. They are sleeping in separate bedrooms as that makes sense for them at this time. I told him I would pray for him and his wife. He wanted to talk and I happened to be there. He mentioned that he never had a serenity and peace with personal spirituality. I listened. He is a Reformed Jew and his wife is a Christian. I suggested he speak with someone, perhaps a rabbi or a chaplain. His son is a physician with the psychiatric unit with a local

hospital. I mentioned that there might be more resources that he had not known about that might be available at little or no cost. Our conversation lasted about 20 minutes.

What if I had been taping the lid up 10 minutes earlier? What if it was the next day? We never know how we may touch others' lives and I truly believe that God had our paths cross. Trash cans? God works in mysterious ways.
